
This year, North Texas Giving Day is this Thursday, September 19! You will be able to donate to MHS Orchestra from now through this Thursday!



#### Q: What do you love most about being in MHS Orchestra?

A: Walking into class every day, knowing I'll leave with something new to practice and improve upon. Orchestra is typically fast-paced and always evolving, which keeps me on my toes and pushes me to grow as a musician, and a person.
